2012 DATA CONVERSION

During 2012, CSPD implemented a new Records Management System (RMS). Part of the implementation involved converting existing data. Efforts were made to minimize data conversion errors, however, 2012 data reported herein may differ from CBI/FBI reports.

The Area Crime Report was previously based on 1990 Census Tract data. The current report will be based on 2010 Census Tract Data.

DYNAMIC CRIME DATA:

The data included in this report is compiled from dynamic files which allow for additions, deletions and/or modifications at any time. As such, the data contained herein represent a ‘snapshot’ of the information available at the time the report was compiled and printed.

In addition, due to differences in cut-off dates, the statistics reported by CSPD may differ from the statistics reported by the Colorado Bureau of Investigation. During 2012, data was reported to CBI at the end of each quarter. Data for the 2012 Annual Statistical Report was generated in 2013 and therefore, many of the corrections needed following the RMS conversion were resolved.

UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING PROGRAM:

Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) is a term used to describe the standard established in 1929 for reporting crime nationwide. There are two main types of UCR reporting: Summary (hierarchical) and NIBRS (incident-based). The current report includes statistics using both methods of reporting.

UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING (UCR) UNDER THE HIERARCHY RULE:

- The traditional method of crime reporting, called Summary Reporting, is based on a hierarchy rule.
- Originally, the hierarchy consisted of 7 offenses including murder/non-negligent manslaughter, forcible rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny-theft, and motor vehicle theft. Arson was later added as an 8th offense.
- Under the hierarchy rule, if more than one crime is committed by the same person, the crime highest in the hierarchy is the only one reported.
- Victims are counted for persons crimes such as homicide, rape and aggravated assault.
- Cases are counted for property and other crime types.

UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING UNDER THE NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM (NIBRS):

- The National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) was established to answer the need for more specificity in crime reporting and is based on incidents.
- NIBRS expands the offense reporting from 8 to 22.
- NIBRS includes revised and new offense definitions.
- NIBRS enables the tracking of explicit and implicit correlations between offenses, property, victims, offenders and arrestees.
- NIBRS places an increased emphasis on drug offenses and accounts for computer crime.
- NIBRS reporting allows for counting up to ten offenses per incident for certain crime types.



APPENDIX A**CRIME DEFINITIONS****National Incident-Based Reporting Standard****GROUP 'A' OFFENSES**

ARSON: To unlawfully and intentionally damage or attempt to damage any real or personal property by fire or incendiary device.

ASSAULT OFFENSES:

Aggravated Assault: An unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in a threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness.

Simple Assault: An unlawful physical attack by one person upon another where neither the offender displays a weapon, nor the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness.

Intimidation: To unlawfully place another person in reasonable fear of bodily harm through the use of threatening words and/or other conduct but without displaying a weapon or subjecting the victim to actual physical attack.

BRIBERY: The offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value (i.e., a bribe, gratuity or kickback) to sway the judgment or action of a person in a position of trust or influence.

BURGLARY/BREAKING AND ENTERING: The unlawful entry into a building or other structure with the intent to commit a felony or theft.

COUNTERFEITING/FORGERY: The altering, copying, or imitation of something, without authority or right, with the intent to deceive or defraud by passing the copy or thing altered or imitated as that which is original or genuine or the selling, buying, or possession of an altered, copied, or imitated thing with the intent to deceive or defraud.

DESTRUCTION/DAMAGE/VANDALISM OF PROPERTY: To willfully or maliciously destroy, damage deface, or otherwise injure real or personal property without the consent of the owner or the person having custody or control of it.

DRUG/NARCOTIC OFFENSES:

Drug/Narcotic Violations: The unlawful cultivation, manufacture, distribution, sale, purchase, use, possession, transportation, or importation of any controlled drug or narcotic substance.

Drug Equipment Violations: The unlawful manufacture, sale, purchase, possession, or transportation of equipment or devices utilized in preparing and/or using drugs or narcotics.

EMBEZZLEMENT: The unlawful misappropriation by an offender to his/her own use or purpose of money, property, or some other thing of value entrusted to his/her care, custody, or control.

EXTORTION/BLACKMAIL: To unlawfully obtain money, property, or any other thing of value, either tangible or intangible, through the use or threat of force, misuse of authority, threat of criminal prosecution, threat of destruction of reputation or social standing, or through other coercive means.

FRAUD OFFENSES:

False Pretenses/Swindle/Confidence Game: The intentional misrepresentation of existing fact or condition or the use of some other deceptive scheme or device to obtain money, goods, or other things of value.

Credit Card/Automatic Teller Machine Fraud: The unlawful use of a credit (or debit) card or automatic teller machine for fraudulent purposes.

Impersonation: Falsely representing one's identity or position and acting in the character or position this unlawfully assumed to deceive others and thereby gain a profit or advantage, enjoy some right or privilege, or subject another person or entity to an expense, charge, or liability that would not have otherwise been incurred.

Welfare Fraud: The use of deceitful statements, practices, or devices to unlawfully obtain welfare benefits.

Wire Fraud: The use of an electric or electronic communications facility to intentionally transmit a false and/or deceptive message in furtherance of a fraudulent activity.

GAMBLING OFFENSES:

Betting/Wagering: To unlawfully stake money or something else of value on the happening of an uncertain event or on the ascertainment of a fact in dispute.

Operating/Promoting/Assisting Gambling: To unlawfully operate, promote, or assist in the operation of a game of chance, lottery, or other gambling activity.

Gambling Equipment Violations: To unlawfully manufacture, sell, buy, possess, or transport equipment, devices, and/or goods used for gambling purposes.

Sports Tampering: To unlawfully alter, meddle in, or otherwise interfere with a sporting contest or event for the purpose of gaining a gambling advantage.

HOMICIDE OFFENSES:

Murder and Non-negligent Manslaughter: The willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another.

Negligent Manslaughter: The killing of another person through negligence.

Justifiable Homicide (Not a Crime): The killing of a perpetrator of a serious criminal offense by a peace officer in the line of duty, or the killing, during the commission of a serious criminal offense, of the perpetrator by a private individual.

KIDNAPING/ABDUCTION: The unlawful seizure, transportation, and/or detention of a person against his/her will or of a minor without the consent of his/her custodial parent(s) or legal guardian.

LARCENY/THEFT OFFENSES:

Pocket-picking: The theft of articles from another person's physical possession by stealth where the victim usually does not become immediately aware of the theft.

Purse-snatching: The grabbing or snatching of a purse, handbag, etc., from the physical possession of another person.

Shoplifting: The theft by someone other than an employee of the victim of goods or merchandise exposed for sale.

Theft From Building: The theft from within a building which is either open to the general public or to which the offender has legal access.

Theft from Coin-Operated Machine or Device: A theft from a machine or device that is operated or activated by the use of coins.

Theft from Motor Vehicle: The theft of articles from a motor vehicle, whether locked or unlocked.

Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts or Accessories: The theft of any part or accessory affixed to the interior or exterior of a motor vehicle in a manner which would make the item an attachment of the vehicle or necessary for its operation.

All Other Larceny: All thefts that do not fit any of the definitions of the specific subcategories of Larceny/Theft listed above.

MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT: The theft of a motor vehicle

PORNOGRAPHY/OBSCENE MATERIAL: The violation of laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, publishing, sale, purchase, or possession of sexually explicit material, e.g., literature or photographs.

PROSTITUTION OFFENSES:

Prostitution: To unlawfully engage in sexual activities for profit.

Assisting or Promoting Prostitution: To solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.

ROBBERY: The taking or attempting to take anything of value under confrontational circumstances from the control, custody, or care of another person by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear of immediate harm.

SEX OFFENSES, FORCIBLE:

Forcible Rape: The carnal knowledge of a person, forcibly and/or against that person's will or not forcibly or against the person's will in instance where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

Forcible Sodomy: Oral or anal sexual intercourse with another person, forcibly and/or against that person's will or not forcibly or against the person's will in instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of his/her youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

Sexual Assault with an Object: To use an object or instrument to unlawfully penetrate, however slightly, the genital or anal opening of the body of another person, forcibly and/or against that person's will or not forcibly or against the person's will in instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent because of her/his youth or because of his/her temporary or permanent mental or physical incapacity.

SEX OFFENSES, NON-FORCIBLE:

Incest: Non-forcible sexual intercourse between persons who are related to each other within the degrees wherein marriage is prohibited by law.

Statutory Rape: Non-forcible intercourse with a person who is under the statutory age of consent.

STOLEN PROPERTY OFFENSES: Receiving, buying, selling, possessing, concealing, or transporting any property with the knowledge that it has been unlawfully taken, as by Burglary, Embezzlement, Fraud, Larceny, Robbery, etc.

WEAPON LAW VIOLATIONS: The violation of laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, sale, purchase, transportation, possession, concealment, or use of firearms, cutting instruments, explosives, incendiary devices, or other deadly weapons.

GROUP 'B' OFFENSES:

BAD CHECKS: Knowingly and intentionally writing and/or negotiating checks drawn against insufficient or nonexistent funds.

CURFEW/LOITERING/VAGRANCY VIOLATIONS: The violation of a court order, regulation, ordinance, or law requiring the withdrawal of persons from the streets or other specified areas; prohibiting persons from remaining in an area or place in an idle or aimless manner; or prohibiting person from going from place to place without visible means of support.

DISORDERLY CONDUCT: Any behavior that tends to disturb the public peace or decorum, scandalize the community, or shock the public sense of morality.

DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE: Driving or operating a motor vehicle or common carrier while mentally or physically impaired as a result of consuming an alcoholic beverage or using a drug or narcotic.

DRUNKENNESS: To drink alcoholic beverages to the extent that one's mental faculties and physical coordination are substantially impaired.

FAMILY OFFENSES, NONVIOLENT: Unlawful, nonviolent acts by a family member (or legal guardian) that threaten the physical, mental, or economic well-being or morals of another family member and that are not classifiable as other offenses, such as Assault, Incest, Statutory Rape, etc.

LIQUOR LAW VIOLATIONS: The violation of laws or ordinances prohibiting the manufacture, sale, purchase, transportation, possession, or use of alcoholic beverages.

PEEPING TOM: To secretly look through a window, doorway, keyhole, or other aperture for the purpose of voyeurism.

RUNAWAY: (Persons under age 18) (Not a Crime): A person under 18 years of age who has left home without the permission of his/her parents(s) or legal guardian.

TRESPASS OF REAL PROPERTY: To unlawfully enter land, a dwelling or other real property.

ALL OTHER OFFENSES: All crimes that are not Group 'A' offenses and not included in one of the specifically named Group 'B' crime categories listed previously.

VICTIM TYPES - VICTIMS OF CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY REPORT

BUSINESS: Privately owned business

FINANCIAL: Banks and banking type institutions

GOVERNMENT: City, state or federal government buildings, property, etc.; public schools

RELIGIOUS: Churches, synagogues, temples; religious organizations and church run schools

PUBLIC: Society in general; mankind as a whole
