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NARRATIVE

BODY WORN CAMERA:

This incident was not captured on body worn camera.

SUSPECT/ARRESTEE STATUS

As of this time, there are no known suspects.

INITIAL INFORMATION (CASE SYNOPSIS)

On 10/05/2016, at approximately 1951 hours, I, Officer R. Thymian/4313 was working in and for the City of Colorado Springs as a police officer. At this time, I was dispatched to the bike path in the area of the 100 block of E. Garden of the Gods Rd. regarding an assault in progress. Reference Call for Service Number 16444716.

OFFICER STATEMENT:

Upon arriving on scene, I was able to make contact with the reporting party, later identified as **JUQUINA JOHNSON (05/29/1994)**, and her husband, who was later identified as **HOWARD STEVENS (DOB: 08/19/1974)** on the bike path on the east side of Pike View Reservoir. (+38.894028 -104.823021)

It should be noted when I arrived on scene, I observed Mr. Stevens lying on the ground and it appeared that he was bleeding from the right side of his head. Mr. Stevens was being tended by AMR personal and was being loaded into the ambulance. I was able to obtain two photographs of Mr. Stevens' injuries prior to being transported.

MS. JOHNSON STATEMENT:

While I was speaking with Ms. Johnson, she stated that at approximately 1940 hours, she and Mr. Stevens were walking southbound on the bike trail on the east side of the water treatment plant. Ms. Johnson stated that as they were walking, they observed two individuals walking northbound at the same location.

Ms. Johnson was able to identify one of the males as Xavier (unknown last). Ms. Johnson stated that the other male was wearing a clown mask.

Ms. Johnson stated that once Mr. Stevens observed the male wearing the clown mask, he became agitated and started yelling "Who's in the mask?". Ms. Johnson stated that the male did not reply. Ms. Johnson stated that this agitated Mr. Stevens even further and he began punching the male in the clown mask.

Ms. Johnson then stated that during the altercation, the unidentified male in the clown mask then hit Mr. Stevens in the face causing him to fall to the ground. Ms. Johnson also stated that during the altercation Xavier started identifying himself and told the two individuals to break up the fight. Ms. Johnson stated that once Mr.

Stevens was taken to the ground, Xavier and the other unidentified male started walking northbound on the bike path.

Ms. Johnson could not provide me with any further information regarding the incident.

OFFICER STATEMENT CONTINUED:

While on scene, I was able to find what appeared to be the scene of the assault. I located several fresh blood droplets on the sidewalk. I took photographs of the scene.

At approximately 2025 hours, I responded to Penrose Main Hospital, located at 2222 N. Nevada Ave. I also gave Ms. Johnson a courtesy transport to the hospital.

Upon arriving on scene, I began to speak with Mr. Stevens. While speaking with Mr. Stevens, he started to become belligerent, and began fighting with hospital staff.

Mr. Stevens would not comply with my request to complete a medical release form regarding his injuries from this incident.

From my training and experience as a police officer it did not appear the injuries were consistent to that of Serious Bodily Injury.

While at the hospital, I gave Mr. Stevens the proper Victim's Rights Paperwork.
