Mr. Hungofer's concern would be the cost to utilize the facility, as there is a nominal fee charged to participants that would almost match the cost to use the facility. Traditionally, a donation from fees collected have been made to the Center and food banks. Mark Snow and Jamie Bequette, Program Administrator, said they would connect with Mr. Hungofer offline to discuss logistics and see what could be done to host this event again.

Additionally, there have been many donations of food from different vendors for the event. Jamie Bequette, Program Administrator, provided an overview of the various activities during the event. Committee member Mary Tauras offered to help distribute fliers for the event. Jamie also announced there would be a production fromm the Funky Little Theater Company in Hughes Hall following the event.

New Working Committee Member Recruitment/Process/Pools/Updated Timeline

Mark Snow, Community Recreation Manager, informed the Committee that there will be interviews for new members on August 31st. Pending how the interviews go, the selected candidates will be confirmed at the next Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Advisory Board meeting so they can participate in the September meeting.

Communications Subcommittee

Committee member Mary Taurus provided a brief update on the communications subcommittee. 400 doorhangers have been ordered and the subcommittee is looking to distribute them between the 17th and 19th of September, from Pikes Peak to Boulder Street. Mary said any additional help in hanging the doorhangers would be appreciated. Parks Advisory Board Liaison Greg Thornton volunteered to help. Felicia Barnhart, Park Operations Administrator, said that she could likely find some of the regular volunteers from the Therapeutic Recreation Program to help, as well.

Community Garden Workday

Staff is hoping to have a workday to get the garden beds ready for winter and are looking for volunteers. There will be a seed harvest on September 15th. Committee Vice Chair Liz Lopez Vaughan suggested a clean-up day sometime after the harvest, in the 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. time frame, potentially the day or week after the harvest. Liz said she would work with Jamie to schedule.

Staff Updates

Westside Community Center Facility Operations – Program/Schedule; Volunteers; New Staff; Outdoor Art; New Bike Rack

Jamie Bequette, Program Administrator, Felicia Barnhart, Park Operations Administrator, and Mark Snow, Community Recreation Manager, provided the following updates to the Committee:

- Lyle Robertson is a new seasonal maintenance staff member at the Center. Additionally, staff are conducting interviews for a maintenance technician. Alexis Shott, who was previously working for the Therapeutic Recreation Program as an intern, has also accepted a seasonal position. With these new staff members, Jamie was very happy to announce that the Center will be open on Saturdays for rentals starting in September.
- Homeschool drop-in has been added to the program schedule.
- There are two brand new bike racks out front.
- Jamie is working to finalize the installation of art outside the center. She is working with a neighbor who is donating an ornate bench. The bench will be in front of the middle building.

Westside Community Center Facility Enhancements – Security Cameras; Facility Budget and Revenue Targets

Mark Snow, Community Recreation Manager, informed the Committee of the following enhancements:

- The installation of security cameras is almost complete. There will be 19 in total.
- Mark distributed the period 6 budget reports and went through a few of the line items. A request to see quarterly reports for all the community centers was made. Mark said he could do this.
