Questions & Answers

1) Is Certificate of insurance required with bid or after award?

A Certificate of Insurance will be required after award as part of contracting documents.

2) EXHIBIT 4 – SAMPLE EVALUATION SCORESHEET - We see the consideration is on these basis. We are just confirming if any of these are to be filled by bidder or this is just for evaluation and you will be considering it only?

A: Bidders should not fill this form out. This is a provided sample to illustrate the criteria for scoring eligible proposals received.

3) Is there any bid bond, payment bond or performance bonds required with bid or after award?

A: Depending on project price payment, performance and maintenance bonds may be required after award. No bid bond is required.

4) Is this subject to Prevailing wage?

A: No.

5) Is there any removal required for existing signage?

A: Yes, There is an existing wooden sign at the corner of 26th and Cucharras that needs to be removed. In addition to this there are numerous existing small metal directional signs that will need to be removed and replaced with a new directional sign 'C' shown in the bid package.

6) For the hanging signs are all the posts existing? we do not need to provide new right? What is the height of existing pols?

A: There are existing posts in all areas for the directional signs 'C' that can be used. Sign height on most poles will vary based on view obstructions and existing incumbrances. Prior to installation heights at each location will be given.

7) Is there any permit required to obtain for work execution?

A: No permits are expected. Contractors are welcome to place permits as a separate line item in the fee sheet.

8) Is this taxable? or the city is exempt from sales tax?

A: This project is subject to City of Colorado Springs sales and use tax, as applicable. Please refer to section 1.20 of RFP Notice.



9) What is the completion timeline for signs to be installed?

A: The goal is 6 months from notice to proceed.
